5. PLANNING

Members discussed current planning applications.

Ref: 23/0782/FH Proposal: Erection of 3 dwellings together with new access.

Location: Land Adjoining Pepperland Nursery, Straight Lane, Brookland

Ref: 23/0864/FH Proposal: Erection of one detached dwelling and associated access, garage/parking and landscaping

Location: Apples Joy, Straight Lane, Brookland, Romney Marsh, TN29 9QS

The Councillors discussed correspondence regarding a retrospective planning application 23/0357/FH Land opposite Spring Bank. The Councillors reconfirmed their previous position on the application and instructed the clerk to respond to the correspondence.

F&HDC Cllr Martin reported back to the Council on several issues:

Anti-Social Behaviour: Meeting arranged with F&H CSU, Cllr Bicknell to attend to discuss damage in church and bell tower and measures to prevent further occurrences.

Romney Marsh PC has now been appointed awaiting contact info

A259: Discussed with local MP – liaison with Kent police to address bike issues and other traffic calming measures used in similar locations. Options for "Unsuitable for HGV" signs to be placed on the Brookland roundabout side lanes, and/or designating "Quiet Lanes" through Campaign to Protect Rural England on the very narrow single track lanes either side of Brookland Village.

7. VILLAGE PLAY AREA & YOUTH RECREATION

Members discussed a proposal to take responsibility from F&HDC for the play area in Salters Lane including refurbishing equipment and replacing the play surface. Full details of the basis on which the area can be passed over to the Parish Council should be available shortly. Further investigation of options for equipment and costs of refurbishment to be completed ready for September meeting.

Other youth play facilities were discussed, Cllr Wallington to approach school about the possibility of the Parish Council providing 5 a side goal posts and marking out pitch.
