Kent and Medway Clinical Commissioning Group (KMCCG) is working with its partners, and people living with dementia and their carers to improve care for people living with dementia who also have complex care needs.

We are seeking the views of people:

NHS and social care staff, domiciliary carers, care home staff, and those voluntary organisations to understand how our health care system is working, and to help identify any gaps or improvements.

the public is being asked about the principles which should be applied to improve the quality of care provided for people living with dementia.
